- 2. <u>2017 Kia Forte</u>
- 3. 2017 Subaru Impreza
- 4. <u>2017 Volkswagen Jetta</u>
- 5. 2017 Toyota Corolla
- 6. <u>2017 Hyundai Elantra</u>
- 7. 2017 Mazda3
- 8. 2017 Chevrolet Cruze

"The Honda Civic looks and feels a size class above the rest of the competitors in this Challenge, and impressive attention to detail and quality make it feel more expensive, too," said Wiesenfelder. "Beyond quality, drivability and features, value is where the Civic really stands out. The sedan comes packed with high-end features at an impressively competitive price."
